Key Dates/Times

June 11 – Swimmer Testing from Troop 314 – Required for all swimmers at camp. If scouts will use free time for swimming, or participate in any other swimming related activities, they need to be tested. Typically held at local YMCA. Being coordinated by John Jones.

June 18: Trunk Dropoff St. Raphael Scout Shed 6:45-7:30pm

June 19: Arrive at parking lot at (North Ridge Center 11:30, Departure at Noon. 2Pm Check-in.

Camp Durant - Campsite: Persimmon

June 25: Return at scout shed – 9:30-10:30am (check ou time is by 9am on Saturday the 25th) Drivers arrive by 7:30am

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

Personal Equipment (Some items available at Trading post, if the scout runs out)

- Medical Exam Form (with all signatures) - Turned in before departure.
 - Medication - To be administered during summer camp. Including detailed instructions.
 - Footlocker (Trunk) - Example "Sterilite Footlocker - Black"
 - Scout Uniform
 - Scout Handbook
 - T-shirts, shorts and jeans
 - Underwear
 - Sweater/Jacket
 - Poncho/Raincoat
 - Sleeping Bag/Ground cloth
 - Pillow
 - Swim trunks
 - Soap, comb, toothbrush
 - Towels and washcloths
 - Water bottle/canteen
 - Flashlight
 - Pocketknife (must fold & be less than 6")
 - Paper and pens
 - Money for Trading Post and crafts (approximately \$50.00)
 - Shoes
- OPTIONAL ITEMS
- Insect repellent
 - Mosquito net - for inside the provided tents
 - Battery Powered Fan
 - Compass
 - Camera
 - Fishing rod and reel (only if fishing, or doing fishing merit badge)
 - ELECTRONICS: Only Electronics approved by Mr. Campbell (list is likely to be extremely short!)
 - Most items Packed in a Trunk..
